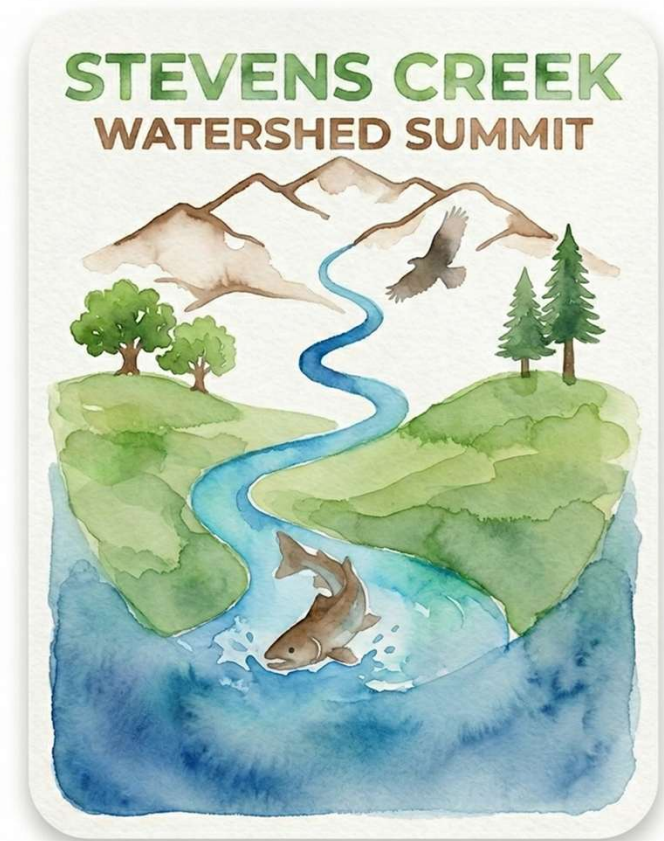

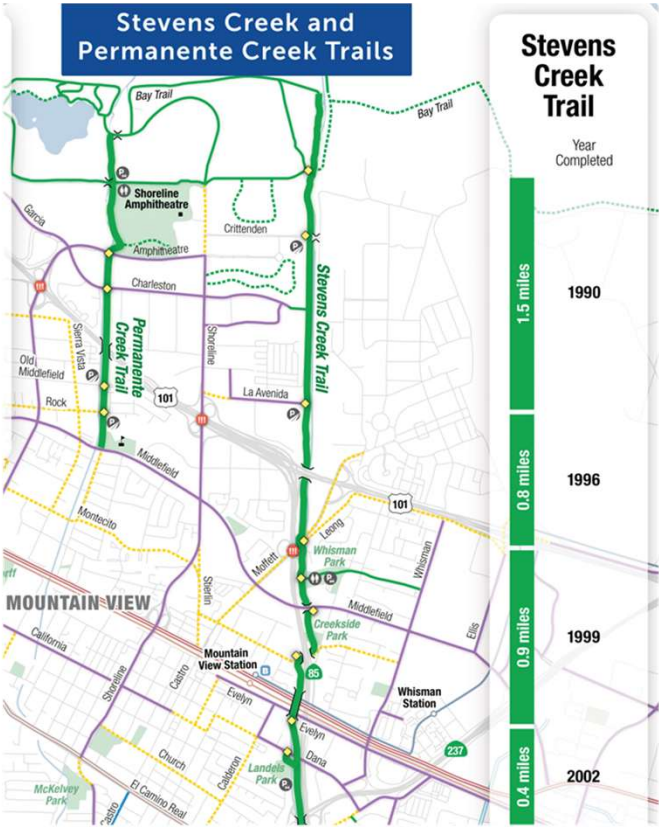

Project History

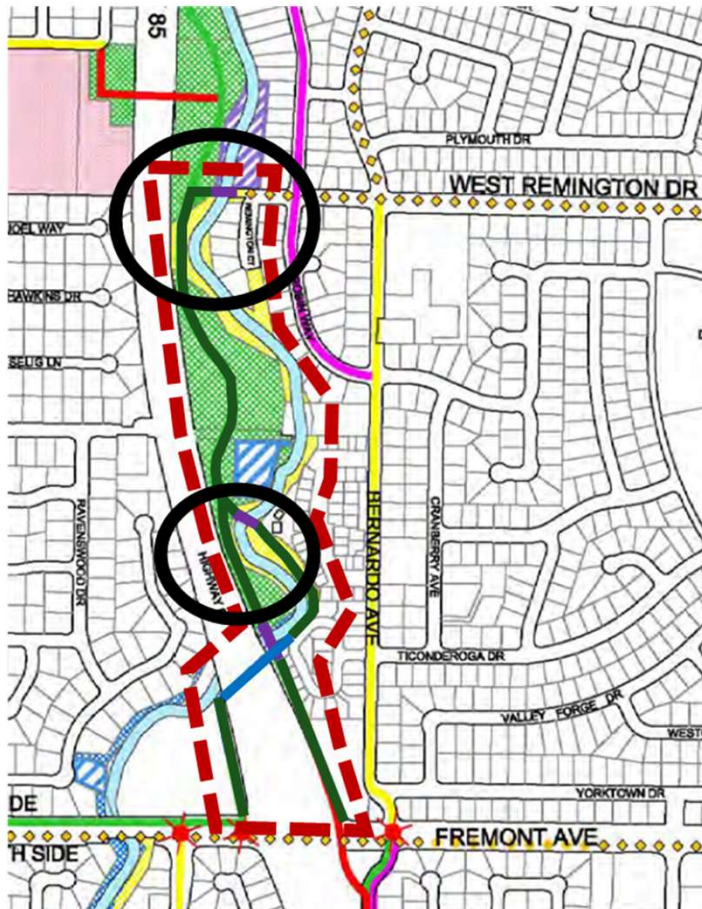

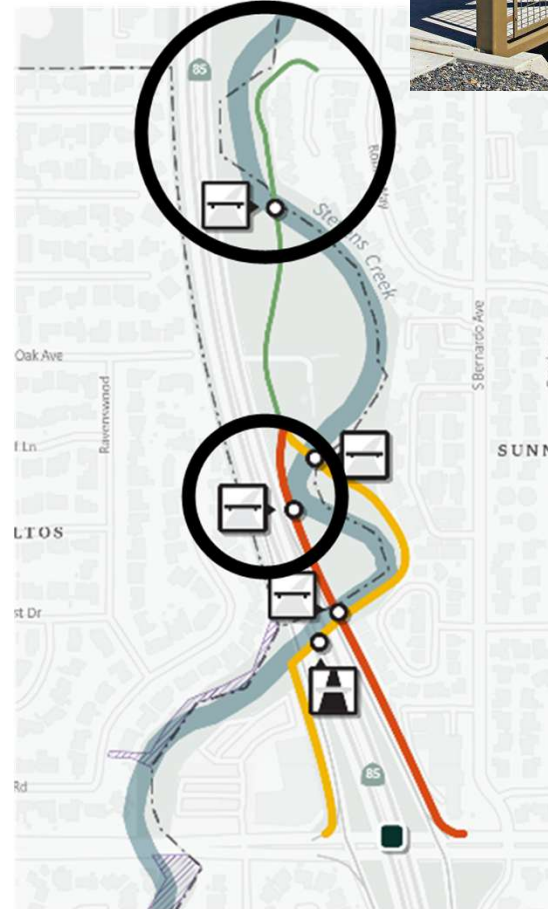


Alignment Comparison

Funding

- Current Project
 - Environmental, Permitting and Design
 - Federal Earmark - \$3M
 - VTA 2016 Measure B - \$3.6M
 - Local match - \$400K
- Construction
 - Costs currently anticipated to be \$40M to \$50M



SR 85 Underpass

- Goes under SR-85
- Connects to Fremont Avenue on west side of SR-85
- Requires large retaining walls and significant grading
- Extensive coordination and permitting with Caltrans and environmental agencies
- Requires flood control improvements
- Could be closed during major storm events


